Dancing in Lynmouth

Formed in 1996 by Jane Harding & a few members of the long running Keep Fit Club, The Lyn Line Dance Club is still as popular today, 12 years on. Sadly Jane died in 1998 after a battle with breast cancer. She entrusted the Club to Heidi, who has instructed the class ever since, aided by a hard working & enthusiastic committee.

Committed to raising funds for Local Charities & also some National Organisations, the Club has raised well over £12,000, of which most of the local clubs & schools have benefitted from, as have a few individuals, most of whom have been members of the Club at some time. Several of the local halls, buildings & schemes in Lynton have also received help from the Club, along with the rescue services, retirement homes & hospices in the region.

The Club have regularly appeared at fetes, galas, parties, country shows, fashion shows, local events & many celebrations in the nearby villages. They have also competed in regional & National level competitions.

Over the past 12 years, over 100 dances have been taught to a wide variety of music styles from reggae, pop, blues, jazz, country, irish & rock & roll. Our main aims are to have fun whilst keeping body & mind active & helping the community also.

Regular weekly classes are held in Lynton, at the Town Hall on a Tuesday evening, from Sept to July, where children & adults of all abilities are catered for. From July to September, on a Tuesday night, the Club takes itself to the neighbouring seaside village of Lynmouth to perform to the general public. This is a pleasant evening of Music & dancing. What better way to enjoy a cold drink from the pub on a warm summer evening on the Lynmouth Harbourside! There is usually a collecting tin circulating for the Clubs chosen charity.
